## THE WOODVILLE TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE'S REGULAR MEETING - February 21, 2024

Chairman Ken Green called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

EMS - LS19 had 30 runs in January.

### **FIRE DEPARTMENT** – Fire Chief Tim Schnitker reported on the following:

- The fire department had 115 runs in 2023.
- 5 radios did not take the new programming codes.
- > Trustee Runion met with Delventhal regarding loose tile that has been found in the meeting room and hallway. He will meet with the tile people tomorrow.

Trustee Runion made a motion to approve waive the hiring requirements for Noah Robleski who is new to town and admit him to the fire department on a probationary basis and allow him to attend fire school to earn his 36-hour firefighting card pending he meets all hiring requirements. Trustee Green seconded. All answered yes to roll call. Motion passed.

## **ZONING** – Zoning Inspector Steve Michaelis reported on the following:

- Presented approved zoning permit #24-01 for Jamie and Meaghan Morris, 2622 CR 24, Gibsonburg (Woodville Township) for 12' x 14' shed for storage. The \$50 permit fee was paid. The shed did not meet the 10' setback zoning requirement, so the Morris' submitted a variance request, paid the \$250 fee, and after a public hearing it was approved by the Zoning Board of Appeals on February 15.
- I discussed current zoning regulations on property on Penn Lane with Eastman & Smith attorneys regarding uses, districts, and light commercial.
- Spoke with David Honaker regarding the cargo container on his property on US 20.

**ROAD DEPARTMENT** – Jim Busdiecker reported he got a quote from Speck Tires for new aluminum rims and mounting at \$260 for each tire on new International plow truck. Trustee Hammer made a motion to purchase aluminum rims from Speck Tires not to exceed \$1,250.00. Trustee Green seconded. All answered yes to roll call. Motion passed.

Trustee Hammer made a motion to accept the engineer's estimate for 2024 road work in the amount of \$198,000 and to have these projects bid out along with projects from Madison and Washington Townships in April. Trustee Runion seconded. All answered yes to roll call. Motion passed.

The roads include:

TR 165 from CR 2 to TR 16 (\$90,000)

TR 165 from Lime Road to the Wyandot Entrance (\$75,000)

TR 167 from CR 44 to box culvert on CR 44 (\$19,000)

TR 163 from R.R. to south of bridge (\$14,000)

<u>CEMETERY</u> – Workers continue to haul in stone for the new roads for the future addition at Westwood Cemetery.

The Trustees signed a cemetery deed for Patricia Gronwall, Woodville, for 1 plot at Westwood Cemetery.

# FISCAL OFFICER - No report.

Trustee Hammer made a motion to approve the warrants. Trustee Runion seconded. All answered yes to roll call. Motion passed. Trustee Green made a motion to approve the February 6, 2024 meeting minutes. Trustee Runion seconded. All answered yes to roll call. Motion passed.

At 8:11 pm, with no further business, Trustee Hammer moved for adjournment. Trustee Green seconded. This meeting was held in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code's Sunshine Law.
